#### **Missionaries Training Pastors in Malawi**

In February 2019, Don transitioned from 30 years of pastoral ministry to become the project director for Equipping Leaders International (ELI) Malawi. Using both in person and virtual methods, he trains pastors who then train other pastors and leaders. ELI Malawi has a long-range strategy to

train over 1000 pastors in Malawi. Over 400 churches are currently receiving training and 20,000 believers are impacted by ELI Malawi's ministry.
